

The Rose of Joy: "Pink Rose Globe Cactus"

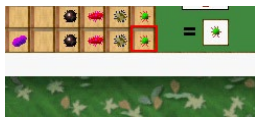
This breathtaking cactus spawns roses so beautiful that people come from miles to behold its wonder. Your nursery will always have a crowd from now on.

If you're thinking of making your own breeding guide for another LDW game:

It helps to look at how the plants and everything are arranged in the code or in the Images folder. They'll always be arranged in a pattern that helps you figure out how to fill out the breeding chart.

Look closely at how the breeding charts are arranged. The tier coloration follows a certain pattern, and the results from each breeding cross do too.

The breeding results are in order from top to bottom by name.

The coloring of the tiers follows a specific order, eg: green-red-blue-red.

Thank goodness there's a pattern - otherwise this guide would've taken 3 weeks to complete! :)

Figuring out the tiers for plants and flowers:

The seeds' appearance will tell you the tier of flowers.

For the plants, you have to grow them in the second soil upgrade:

Tier 1 plants are included in the common seeds and will grow in all soil types.

Common seeds = the first type of seeds in the store

Tier 2 plants will lose health unless grown in the second soil. They will not appear in the common seeds.

Tier 3 plants will lose health in the second soil, but should survive to adulthood and produce seeds before death.

Tier 4 plants will not survive to adulthood and seed production, unless instagrow is used.
